

Year 11 Online Lessons and Assessment Changes for week beginning 10th May 2021

Following the isolation of year 11 from 5th May – 17th May, we have adjusted parts your assessments. Depending on the subject this may involve some of the following:

- Adapting a piece of assessment for completion through remote learning assessment (i.e a live assessment via teams)
- Removing certain questions or papers that were planned.
- Changes to the format of your assessment (i.e presentations, discussions to assess understanding, GCSE Pod, Dr Frost)
- Adapting the proportions of assessment methods in relation to the original.

To support you and your CDG's the following gives you information and details on how your teachers have amended your lessons and assessments due to having to work from home this week.
