“I have enjoyed seeing my friends in school and making new ones. I like the nice teachers too. I have really enjoyed moving around to the other classes and the playground is huge”.







“The things I have enjoyed so far at Cardiff West are Maths, Science, Technology and Computing. Maths is a challenge and Computing teaches you more about IT and email”.




